

Rules and Regulations

1. Rules of the U.S.T.A shall govern play. Players are required to have a current U.S.T.A. card in their possession, or one may be obtained at the tournament desk.
2. Each player is limited to 1 singles and 1 doubles event.
3. Events must have a minimum of three entries. The size of the draw may be limited.
4. All matches will be the best of three sets. At six games all the twelve-point tie-breaker will be in effect. No Ad scoring will be used through the quarterfinals.
5. Tennis attire must be worn for all matches.
6. Players may be defaulted after 15 minutes from match time.
7. Warm-up is limited to ten minutes.
8. Players may be asked to serve as linespersons.
9. The point penalty system will be in effect. The tournament director reserves the right to reject any entry or default any player who refuses to cooperate with the tournament committee.
10. Parents or coaches will not be allowed on the courts during matches.
11. Consolation rounds will be played for singles only.
12. Housing is not available.
13. U.S.T.A. Junior Age Rules:
 - B-G 18's Player born July. 1, 1991 or later
 - B-G 16's Player born July. 1, 1993 or later
 - B-G 14's Player born July. 1, 1995 or later
 - B-G 12's Player born July. 1, 1997 or later
14. Starting times will be available after **6PM** on Monday, June 21st online at pnw.usta.com, or call the club at (253) 872-5545 (ext. 1).
15. Refunds will not be granted once draws have been made.
16. Trophies or plaques will be awarded to the winners and runners up of each age division.
17. Entry fees must accompany entry form or name will not be placed in the draw.

Consolation matches may be played at an outdoor site.
