SENIOR TENNIS LEAGUE - COME JOIN IN THE FUN

USTA League Tennis is a fun and competitive format enjoyed by 325,000 players nation wide. There are three divisions in USTA League Tennis: Adult, Senior, and Mixed Doubles. The following describes the Senior League of play.

Senior Division

In 1991 the USTA introduced a National Senior Division of the USTA League Tennis program, it has proven to be friendly, fun and competitive. Here in our PNW League, we cover Alaska, Washington and Oregon and currently there are nearly 3,500 senior players enjoying the competition. Our local division has nearly 1,000 senior players competing out of twenty local clubs as far north as Bellingham and south to the Boeing Tennis Club.

Requirements:

- Participants must be 50 years or older
- USTA membership is required
- If you do not have a current NTRP rating you may self rate
- The format is three doubles courts with teams of 6 or more players competing at your level
- Play is for men and women teams at levels of **2.5 to 4.5**
- Senior League season runs from August 14th thru November 8th

Competition culminates with Local Area Playoffs, Sectional Playoffs in Sun River, Oregon and National Championships somewhere in the country.
