BETC finally reopened under Phase 1 restrictions on Monday, January 11. In total, we were closed 148 days during the two closures of 2020-2021.

Most of the guidance released by the State rolled over from the previous re-opening guidelines. We are still asking members to enter the facility no earlier than 5 minutes before a reservation and play must stop with the first bell. The mezzanine, workout area and showers are still closed.

However, we are now allowed to have lessons with up to five students and we have loosened some restrictions on ball machine rental on advice of the USTA. Tournaments and USTA matches may return when our region reaches Phase 2, currently scheduled for February 1. **Masks are still required by the State in Phase 2.**

By far the biggest change is the new requirement to wear a mask during play. We thank members for overwhelmingly adhering to this policy through the first few weeks of our reopening.

**Please note that masks are required to cover your nose and mouth** and should only be removed if you are getting a drink and are physically distanced from your partner or opponent.

Like you, we hope there are no additional closures in the future. By following the State and Club guidelines, we can make that a reality while keeping each other safe.

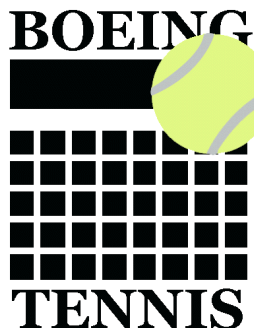
Beginning in February, we will be open until 11:00PM Tuesday-Friday. This is a trial schedule and may change based on demand.

**Question:** Is there any research which identified the potential for COVID-19 to be transmitted on tennis balls?

**Answer:** A recent study determined that the surface of sports balls, notably football, golf, cricket and tennis balls, are unlikely to harbor SARS-CoV-2 in a manner that is compatible with risk of developing COVID-19 from handling the ball during normal play. The International Tennis Federation (ITF) Sport Science and Medicine Commission, the USTA Sport Science Committee and the USTA Medical Advisory Group support this decision.
